This is Special Agent Ben Ziesemer. The time now is approximately 2:55 pm. The date is August 9th, 2005. The following will be a recorded phone call to phone number 503-957-0190.

BZ: Hello, this is Ben

DB: Yes, this is David.

BZ: Hey, David this is Ben uh, the guy that uh, _____ a while ago....

DB: The what now?

BZ: uh, I bought a Smith and Wesson from you, ah, a while ago down in Like uh, what is that Sherwood.

DB: Yeah.

BZ: You never called me about that gun in Washington.

DB: What's that?

BZ: You never gave me a call _____ to go get that gun in Washington

DB: Okay, hold on a second. (STATIC) What was that you were asking me about?

BZ: Oh, I, __ Anyway. I 'm that guy who bought that Smith and Wesson from you awhile ago.

DB: Yeah. Yeah.

BZ: Yeah and uh, I got some money again and I' m lookin' at uh, I don't know if I want another pistol or like a, maybe like an assault rifle or a shot gun or something. (STATIC) I can't hear real well, now.

DB: Yeah, okay, I, I never uh, I never called you about that gun in Washington because it already sold.

BZ: Oh, okay

DB: Is what happened. Yeah, I called the guy and it sold. I've got uh....

BZ: I, I can hear ya' better now.

DB: Okay, yeah I just moved, I wasn't getting that good of a signal. I've, I've got some uh, some really nice, inexpensive, ah, pump shot guns for like, two twenty five, that are, ah, a copy of the, Ithaca, with bottom ejection. There a pump and they have ghost ring sights, a five round mag, too. Those are pretty cool. And then I've got, I've got actually, you had mentioned that you were interested in a forty-five. I've got kind of an interesting forty five pistol with a Witness uh, um Italian, you know _____ carry comp with a compensator on it. So it really is kind of an interesting deal. It is in the box, unfired, and so is the shot gun. And then I've, uh, I've recently acquired a fair amount of uh, AK-47's. I've got a 223 Siaga that I customized and a 762 by 39.

BZ: Is the uh,

DB: And a 308 uh, semi auto rifle you might be interested in.

BZ: Oh. Cool. Yeah, see, I, I don't know uh, I really don't know what I want. Is there any way I can take a look at them or something.

DB: Um, yeah, the uh, It would probably be kind of difficult to like meet you in a parking lot or somethin' somewhere cuz that's a significant amount of stuff

BZ: Yeah, I agree

DB: but if you want to meet, ah, kind of close to 205, you could meet at my shooting range in Estacada and uh, I could just lay everything out on the shooting bench and show it all to you.

BZ: The shooting range in Estacada. Yeah, that sounds cool.

DB: Yeah

BZ: Um where's that at?

DB: Um, it's um, The Estacada exit is like, Exit 12 or 13 off of 205. It says Clackamas/Estacada. If you're coming down 205, it's just past, ah, Johnson Creek.

BZ: Okay, do you have an address? I'll just look it up on MapQuest.

DB: Um, it's called the Estacada Rod and Gun Club.

BZ: Okay

DB: And I'm not sure of the address. I haven't sent anything in to them in awhile. So, you can just look it up on the, on the internet. I think they have some stuff on the website.

BZ: Okay. Then uh, I've got a, well I don't have any time today. Do you have, are you free at all tomorrow?

DB: Yeah, tomorrow is actually a good day, I'm kinda busy today. I was just, just getting' ready to run over to my bank actually, but yeah, tomorrow would be a great day if you want to get together and look at some stuff.

BZ: Okay. How about like uh, I don't know, early afternoon, like around one or so?

DB: Okay. One o'clock would be fantastic. Why don't you call me before you heading out to make sure you have good directions and everything.

BZ: Yeah it's probably a good idea. I will um, I'll give you a call like you know, uh around lunch time tomorrow.

DB: Okay.

BZ: And then, I'll just try and plan on one and I'll see you out there. Is it um, is it ike far off 205.?

DB: It's about uh, It's probably about fifteen miles off of 205,

BZ: Okay, sounds good

DB: So yeah, okay alright I'll talk to ya later

BZ: Okay, I'll give you a call tomorrow. Later

DB: Bye.
