

ATTENTION MEMBERS: LOOK BEYOND THE WAC BADGE

When selling or trading guns, verify the other person's I.D. by checking their drivers license.

IMPORTANT: INTERSTATE TRANSFERS

If you do not have a Federal License (F.F.L. or C&R), be sure to follow the law governing transactions with persons who do not reside in your own state. Generally, cartridge firearms made after 1898 are subject to 1968 Gun Control Act and later revisions.

Interstate Transfers of rifles and shot guns must be recorded through an F.F.L. Dealer. Transfers of handguns must be processed through an F.F.L. Dealer licensed in the same state as the buyer. We have a F.F.L. dealer that will help you with any transfers that you need to have done. Please ask at the table rent desk or the membership desk for info. If you have questions regarding the law please ask at the club director's table or SAF/CCRKBA table.

NOTE:

A WAC member in Oregon was recently raided by BATF and Oregon Police. His collection of over 100 guns was seized as well as tax returns and other items. He has been accused of selling guns at gun shows in Washington in violation of Federal Laws. Some of the buyers were allegedly undercover BATF agents.
